Power sourced from renewable energy suppliers including solar and wind.

Backup fuel storage tanks support the site generators.

Birmingham has multiple network providers via 2 diverse routes to the site terminating within the facility.

Cooling

Minimum N+1 on cooling mechanical infrastructure. Chillers across all halls with downflow units.

Fire Protection

VESDA smoke detection and Gas suppression system in halls.

Birmingham is located right at the heart of this important economic region. Built to tier 3 standards it is a first class facility with excellent connectivity.

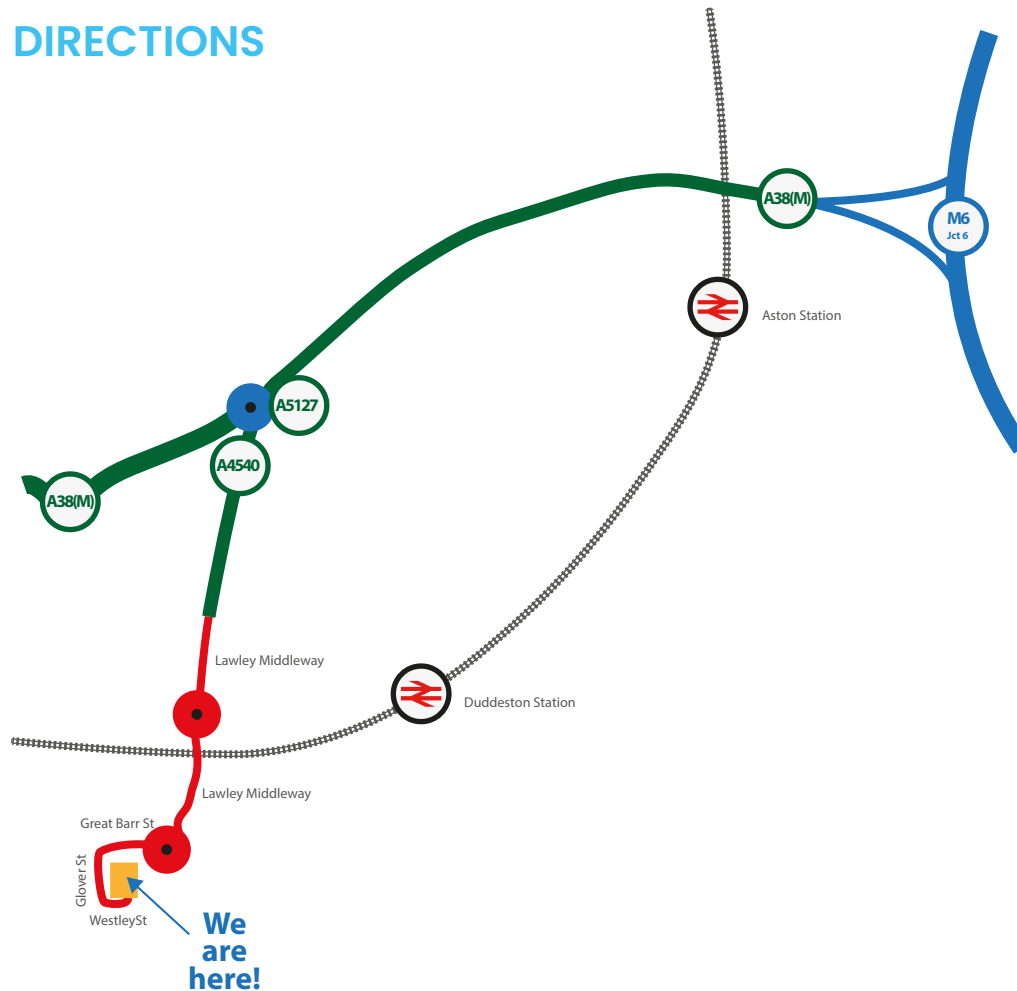

From the M1 (Example)

- 1 Come off at Jct 6 (Spaghetti Junction) and merge onto A38(M).
- 2 Take the ring road A4540 exit.
- 3 Merge onto Aston Rd/A5127. At Dartmouth Circus roundabout, take the 1st exit onto Dartmouth Middleway/A4540.
- 4 Continue straight onto Lawley Middleway/A4540.
- 5 At Curzon Circus roundabout, take the 2nd exit and stay on Lawley Middleway/A4540
- 6 At Leciter Circus roundabout, take the 3rd exit onto Great Barr St and then take the 2nd left onto Glover St. Take the first left into Westley St. The Security Office will be located on your left opposite retail park.

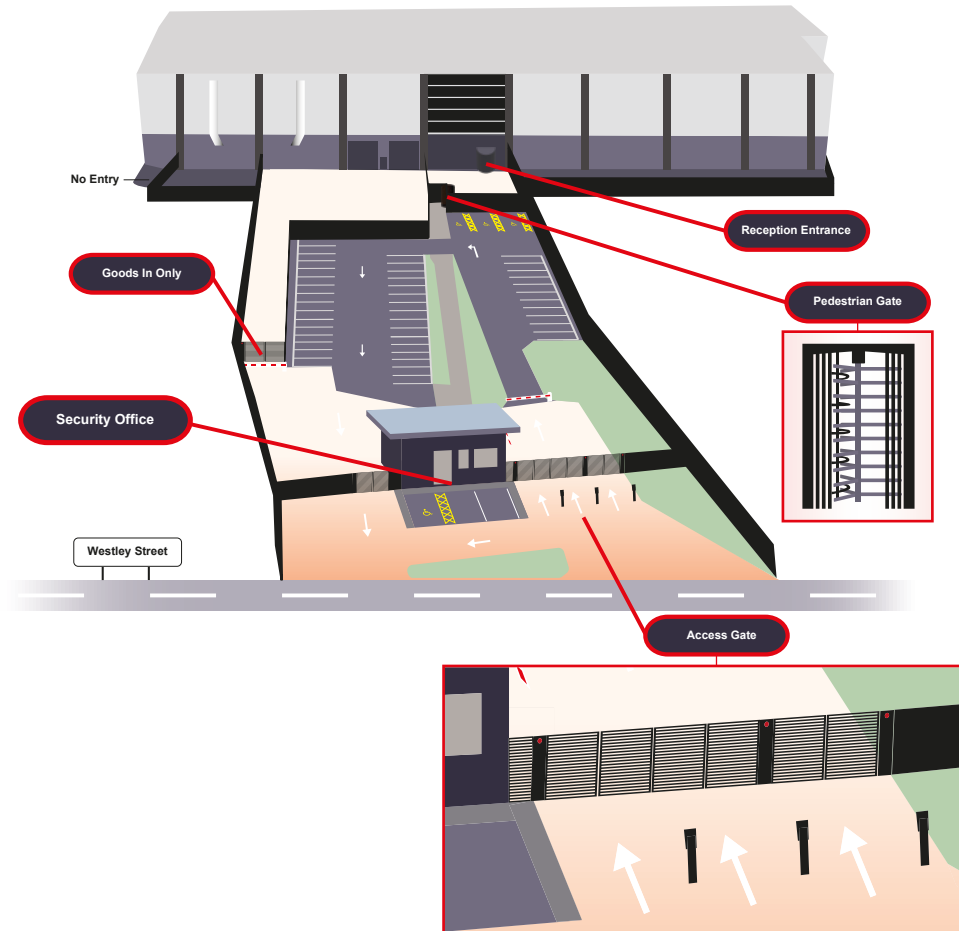

Entry Instructions

Upon arrival, please speak to Security Office to confirm your name and show your photo ID. Security will then issue you with a "Visitor" security pass and pin number which is required on the Pedestrian Gate and at Reception Entrance. If you have driven, you will be advised on which vehicle access gate will be opened and which parking space can be used on-site.

Reception

When you arrive in the Reception Area, notify the reception team of your arrival. They will advise on any further site requirements before enabling internal access and providing directions.
